ANNUAL REPORT OF THE OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY COMMITTEES REPORT OF THE CHAIRMEN OF OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY COMMITTEES

I. PURPOSE

To advise the Council of the work undertaken by the three Overview and Scrutiny Committees in the year 2013/2014.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

That the report be noted.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1. In accordance with the Constitution of the Council the Overview and Scrutiny Committees are required to report annually to full Council on their workings and make recommendations for future work programmes and amended working methods if appropriate.
- 3.2. The main items considered by each committee are summarised in the appendices to this report. In addition regular reports on committee work programmes, Cabinet work programme and performance indicators were received by each meeting.
- 3.3. All three committees considered the draft budget proposals in November/December 2013 and made recommendations for consideration by Cabinet.

Economic and Social Overview & Scrutiny Committee

- 3.4. The Committee had a very busy work programme for the year and considered many important issues within its wide ranging remit.
- 3.5. As in previous years the committee has been proactive in inviting representatives of other organisations to attend meetings to discuss issues and answer questions. This year representatives from South Central Ambulance Service, Cottsway Housing, Thames Valley Police, Age UK, West Oxfordshire Early Intervention Service and GLL Better have attended.
- 3.6. There have been significant changes in legislation and guidance in a number of areas, particularly in relation to Welfare Reform and changes to the provision of health services and the committee will be monitoring the impact of changes in the future.
- 3.7. The committee has continued to monitor progress in respect of issues at RAF Brize Norton, Community Safety matters and development of the Local Development Framework.
- 3.8. During the year the committee became aware of a particular issue regarding Cottsway Housing Association and a special meeting was held in June 2013. The Chief Executive of the Association attended the meeting to answer questions and outline the systems that had been put in place to address the problems that had arisen.

- 3.9. In July the committee received an update from the Area Commander for Thames Valley Police. Consideration was also given to the draft Community Safety Strategy 2013-2017 and a report relating to the management of the night time economy in the district.
- 3.10. The committee has also focused on the economy of the district and issues affecting businesses. In particular a review group has been established to look at the impact of the Marriotts Walk development and they have received input from a number of sources including a retail expert. The committee is also looking at rural broadband in respect of both residential and business users.
- 3.11. A table showing the items considered at each meeting is attached as Appendix A.

Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee

- 3.12. A major focus of the Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee in the past year has been the impact of flooding and sewerage issues in the district. The committee has met with Thames Water to discuss issues of concern and has continued to lobby to get matters rectified. The flooding experienced in the area during the winter has also been reviewed by the committee.
- 3.13. In respect of the waste contract the Committee have been receiving regular update reports and a performance monitoring report was received at the March 2014 meeting. The Committee has also considered the 'in-house' commercial waste and recycling service and the marketing of this to increase the number of users.
- 3.14. The Committee considered a new Environmental and Low Carbon Plan and recommended approval to the Cabinet. The document replaces the previous Climate Change Policy the document details key actions the Council will undertake and it will be reviewed and performance monitored each year and updated where necessary.
- 3.15. During the year the committee has received presentations in respect of a number of issues. This included a presentation from the Building Research Establishment (BRE) who had been commissioned to undertake the Stock Condition Survey and Health Impact Assessment of properties in West Oxfordshire.
- 3.16. At the January 2014 meeting the committee received an update presentation in respect of the Air Quality Management Areas and Strategy for the district.
- 3.17. Another major report was received at the March 2014 meeting in respect of the future provision of public conveniences in the district.
- 3.18. A Notice of Motion relating to traffic matters in Bladon was referred to the committee by Council and detailed consideration was given to the issues raised. As a result the Council, as recommended by the committee, supported the views of residents and wrote to Oxfordshire County Council seeking highway improvements.
- 3.19. A table showing the main items considered at each meeting is attached as Appendix B.

Finance and Management O&S Committee (FMOS)

- 3.20. It has been another challenging year for the Council as the prevailing economic conditions have become increasingly tight and the outlook ever more uncertain. FMOS has been at the forefront of the fight to cut costs and identify efficiencies wherever possible and give advice on the way forward for the Council.
- 3.21. Members considered a report at the June 2013 in respect of performance of the current property investments held by the council. The committee has also considered

the impact of the New Homes Bonus and Localisation of Business Rates on council finances.

- 3.22. During the year the committee has considered the call-in of a cabinet decisions relating to the Greystones Depot at Chipping Norton and the disposal of land in Woodstock. In addition Notices of Motion were referred by Council in respect of Support for the Local Economy and also The Living Wage and in both cases the committee gave detailed consideration to the matters and made recommendations to Council.
- 3.23. The committee has continued to undertake service efficiency reviews by receiving presentations from Heads of Service and looking in detail at the work undertaken and efficiency measures introduced in those areas of work. During the year information was received relating to the work of the Business Information and Change and Customer Service sections.
- 3.24. Reports were also received in respect of Contract and Procurement arrangements and the new Community Infrastructure Levy including the impact on the delivery of affordable housing.
- 3.25. As in previous years the committee has received regular reports on treasury management activity and performance and also performance indicators relating to the work of the committee. Recommendations were also made to Cabinet on the Budget for 2014/2015 and the annual review of the Medium Term Financial Strategy.
- 3.26. The matters considered at each meeting is summarised at Appendix C.
