3.1. At the meeting of this Committee held on 28 May 2015 five reports together with a presentation were received and considered.

Meeting the Needs of an Ageing Population

- 3.2. The Committee received a presentation from officers of the council and representatives of organisations working with people living with dementia and their families in the district.
- 3.3. Members asked a number of questions and after a detailed discussion it was resolved:
 - (a) That the information provided at the meeting be noted; and
 - (b) That a further report on the issues raised be considered at a future meeting.

Local Plan Monitoring Report 2013/2014

- 3.4. Consideration was given to the report of the Strategic Director regarding the Council's Local Plan monitoring report for 2013/14 prepared in accordance with the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012.
- 3.5. After discussion it was resolved that, the content of the 2013/2014 Local Plan monitoring report is noted for information
- 3.6. The Cabinet considered the report at a meeting on 17 June 2015 where the report was agreed subject to the following amendments:
 - (a) Page 27 Table 11 Local Plan employment land allocations update 2014 Column 1, Row 2 amended to read 'East of Downs Road, West Witney'
 - (b) Page 32 Additional Paragraph added:
 - 5.6 Permission was granted in 2013 (13/0530/P/CM) for extended sand and gravel extraction in the Lower Windrush Valley around Gill Mill. The Council recognises that there are opportunities to introduce beneficial after uses to areas such as this

including biodiversity enhancements and eco-tourism potential associated with new reed beds, meadows and woodlands.
