I. PURPOSE

To provide information on the Council's performance as at the end of Quarter 1, 2015/16.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1. The Appendix to this report provides detailed performance information as at the end of Quarter I 2015/16 for performance indicators relating to Public Protection, Housing Support, Planning and Strategic Housing, Leisure and Communities and Legal and Property Services.
- 3.2. Analysis of the results has highlighted that the Council's overall performance for these services remains good.
- 3.3. There are 14 Performance Indicators relating to the work of this Committee and of these 12 are reported quarterly with targets set, one reports quarterly but has no target set and one reports annually.
- 3.4. Reported performance indicates that 10 (83%) achieved target (Green) and 2 (16%) missed target (Red). The underperforming indicators are considered in more detail below:

Red Indicator - Missed target

PL4 – Planning Building Control: Percentage of full plans checked within 21 calendar days of receipt

Target: 80% Actual: 69.39%

During Quarter I the Building Control Section was one member of staff down due to a retirement and the recruitment of a suitable candidate proving difficult. This put pressure on the team with regard to plan checking. The post has been advertised again and new methods of working are being investigated. Despite the staffing issues the improvement in performance seen in Quarter 4 2014/2015 has continued.

PL5 – Planning: The number of planning appeals decisions allowed against the Authority's decision to refuse planning applications, as a percentage of the total number of planning appeals against refusals of planning applications.

Target: 30% Actual: 38.46%

The outturn of 38.46% represents 5 out of 13 decisions that were allowed. This indicator has a very small population and therefore a small variation in performance can result in a large variance in outturn. It is noted that had 4 out of 13 been achieved, rather than 5, the indicator would have been green.
