- Increased management team onsite to oversee running of festival.
- A qualified Sound Engineer will be engaged throughout the planning process and will be available at all times during the licenced hours to monitor sound levels both on and off site. The Sound Engineer will liaise closely with the Council Environmental Health Officer both in advance and during the event to ensure all conditions are adhered to.
- Taste Festivals Limited will ensure the Sound Engineer monitors from specific residential properties where requested.
- Taste Festivals Limited will set up a residents complaint line for use throughout the event days so that residents can directly contact the event management team with any concerns that may arise.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Additions due to variation of license (if any);

- Larger security response team to cover the extended opening hours to deal with crime or risks of crime, and additional security patrols both during the event and overnight.

c) Public safety

Additions due to variation of license (if any);

- Security response team to cover the extended opening hours to deal with crime or risks of crime, and additional security patrols both during the event and overnight. The command and control structure for security (management and a joint control room) will still be in place with appropriate increases in hours.
- Great number of experienced and qualified people in the management team. The management team for The Big Feastival will include those from 2013 augmented by more staff to ensure the smooth running of the event over the extended hours.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- Further planning and staffing will be engaged to manage the extended opening hours of the event to continue to ensure minimal disruption to the local residents and area. Extended staffing to include medical and SIA guards and stewards.
- Taste Festivals Limited propose meeting with the appropriate parish councils to pro-actively manage any concerns they may have in advance of the event taking place.
- A qualified Sound Engineer will be engaged throughout the planning process and will be available at all times during the licenced hours to monitor sound levels both on and off site. The Sound Engineer will liaise closely with the Council Environmental Health Officer both in advance and during the event to ensure all conditions are adhered to.
- Taste Festivals Limited will ensure the Sound Engineer monitors from specific residential properties where requested.
- Taste Festivals Limited will review the site layout from 2014 and will work closely with the Sound Engineer to locate any secondary music stages or indoor PA systems in the least noise sensitive areas. As outlined in the licence variation request, any recorded music being played after 11pm will be contained within a limited number of indoor spaces to avoid public nuisance.
- Taste Festivals Limited will set up a residents complaint line for use throughout the event days so that residents can directly contact the event management team with any concerns that may arise.
