Parish/Town Council	<p>The Council discussed this licence when the Mayor's Committee met on 22nd March. At this meeting the Council resolved that:</p> <p>Woodstock Town Council has concerns about this application because it is situated in a densely populated residential area and there is potential for public nuisance resulting from music playing until 11pm most nights and midnight on Saturdays and Sundays. WTC also notes that this includes using the gardens for functions. Open air events in the centre of a residential area would cause serious nuisance and disturbance to many people who live in close proximity to these premises.</p>
