Further representations have been received from Mr Gill that are detailed below:

Mr Gill - 2 Bakers Piece

On page 10m of the report a condition of any development will be that a full surface water drainage plan shall be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority. This and technical details is to ensure the proper provision for surface water drainage and/or to ensure flooding is not exacerbated in the locality (The West Oxfordshire Strategic Flood Risk Assessment, National Planning Policy Framework and Planning Statement No 25 Technical Guidance).

However, one wonders with climate change allowances whether the Developers' tolerances will be sufficient? Furthermore with the proposed 3 new dwellings the loss of flood plain storage because of this within 1% of flood extent whether an appropriate allowance for climate change will be factored in? In addition will the 'uncultivated' garden site achieve a level for flood plain compensation?

With the flooding in July 2007, particularly in Cumbria but also Witney the recommendation of the Government Water Agency was that more trees should be placed there and in other affected areas to help prevent flooding. At Bakers Piece, we have mature Ash, Sycamore and other specious in the proposed development site which absorb thousands of gallons of water' The felling of such trees from this site, as proposed would risk flooding in the close. Also, the partial removal of the boundary wall would further worsen such a risk by water running through the gap. left. Could Councillors and others reject this proposal outright. I, and I'm sure most of you were witness to the Witney July floods and BP were very fortunate to miss this catastrophe. Thanks for reading this.
