#### I. PURPOSE

To receive and consider any representations arising from the consultation period regarding the Council's proposals for the amendment of Street Trading Controls in West Oxfordshire.

#### 2. RECOMMENDATIONS

That a resolution be passed in accordance with Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 that with effect from 1 May 2015 the following streets (attached as Appendix A) be designated as prohibited streets (in addition to the prohibited streets already designated by the Council) including all forecourts, roads, footways or other areas adjacent to the streets referred to in this resolution for a distance of 10 metres from the edge of the adopted highway and that the following streets (attached as Appendix B)including all forecourts, roads, footways or other areas adjacent to the streets for a distance of 10 metres from the edge of the adopted highway shall for the purposes of the Act be designated as consent streets(in addition to the consent streets already designated by the Council).

#### 3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1. At its meeting of 29 January 2015, the Miscellaneous Sub-Committee resolved to give notice that it intended to pass a resolution in respect of streets in West Oxfordshire. The notice was published in the Witney Gazette on 4 February 2015 inviting responses within 28 days. The notice was also served on the Thames Valley Police and Oxfordshire County Council Highways.
- 3.2. The closing date for the receipt of any representations is 4 March 2015. At the time of writing this report no representations have been received. Any representations that are received will be reported verbally at the meeting.
- 3.3. If the Licensing Sub Committee agrees to pass the resolution, the Council must now publish a notice that the resolution has been passed in two consecutive weeks in a local newspaper again circulating in the relevant area. The first publication must be at least 28 days before the day specified in the resolution for the coming into force of the designation. It is intended to publish this notice (Appendix C) in the Witney Gazette on 18 March 2015 and 25 March 2015.

#### 4. ALTERNATIVES/OPTIONS

The Sub-Committee may choose not to pass a resolution in respect of the Streets in West Oxfordshire.

# 5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The cost of public advertisements can be met from existing budgets.

## 6. REASONS

The Council exercises control over Street Trading operations in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.
