I. PURPOSE

Permission was granted on appeal in 2013 (APP/D3125/A/12/2187065) for the change of use of the former agricultural field to a use as a natural burial ground.

The application is likely to be presented to the Uplands Planning Committee in February 2018 and officers consider that it would be expedient for members to visit the site in order to appreciate the context in which the building would be sited and to appreciate the principle issues which need to be considered when determining this application.
