- 6. Public Path Diversion Land at Harcomb Farm Chastleton (Pages 111 114)

 Purpose:
 - 1.1 To seek authority for Officers to make a Public Path Diversion Order under Section 257 the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and carry out the required statutory consultation upon it.
 - 1.2 The diversion is necessary to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission applied for under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: Construction of an extension to the existing agricultural building.
 - 1.3 The path will remain accessible and enjoyable to the public as a consequence of the diversion.
