I Election of Chair

The Head of Democratic and Electoral Services opened the meeting and sought nominations for the position of Chair of the Committee for the remainder of 2024/25.

Councillor Smith proposed Councillor Graham as Chair. This was seconded by Councillor Saul. There were no other nominations. This was put to the vote and agreed by the Committee.

The Committee resolved to elect Councillor Graham as Chair of the Performance and Appointments Committee for the remainder of the 2024/25 Council year.

6 Matters exempt from publication

The Chair proposed that the Committee agree to exclude the press and public from the meeting for the remaining items of business. This was seconded, put to a vote and agreed unanimously by the Committee.

The Committee Resolved in accordance with the provisions in Section 100A(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 to:

Exclude the press and public from the meeting in accordance with the provisions of Section 100A(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 on the grounds that their presence could involve the likely disclosure of exempt information relating to candidates for interview as defined in Paragraphs I and 3 of Schedule I2A of the Local Government Act 1972, and the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.

7 Salaries and Terms and Conditions of Chief Officers

The HR Business Partner presented the report which considered the salaries and terms and conditions of the Council's Chief Officers.

The HR Business Partner explained that the proposed changes were a direct result of the transition of 65 employees from Publica to the Council, whereas previously the Chief Officers had no line management responsibilities.

The Committee sought assurances that the proposed salaries were reasonable and reflected the employment market for these roles.

The HR Business Partner clarified that the terms and conditions were proposed to change from NJC to JNC. This was because over time the incorrect contracts had been issued.

The recommendation was proposed by Councillor Graham and seconded by Councillor Mead, was put to the vote and agreed unanimously by the Committee.

The Performance and Appointments Committee resolved to recommend to Council to:

I. Approve the appropriate salary for the post of Chief Executive Officer, Director of Finance, and Director of Governance effective from I November 2024 and the movement to Joint National Committee (JNC) Terms and Conditions.
