Officer Support

Democratic Services will organise and support the meetings of the Review Group and produce any report/recommendations arising from the review.

The Strategic Projects Lead (Leisure) will advise the Group with input from the Leisure Contract Specialist, other services (e.g. Estates Team) and GLL as required.

Background and rationale

The Overview and Scrutiny Committee established the Leisure and Wellbeing Strategy Task and Finish Group on 6 December 2023.

The Council has appointed Max Associates to undertake a Strategic Outcomes Planning Model (SOPM) which will inform the developing of a strategic approach to the Council's sport, leisure and physical activity Services. This approach will be articulated in the Council's emerging Leisure and Wellbeing Strategy.

The condition of the Council's existing leisure facilities is not directly related to the strategy. However, the Committee has raised concerns about the condition of some of the Council's leisure centres and it is proposed that the Task and Finish Group will also consider the Council's arrangements and plans for the repair and maintenance of its leisure centres.

Purpose of the Review

The purpose of the review is to:

- 1. Provide member oversight of, and input into, the Council's emerging Strategic Outcomes Planning Model (Leisure and Wellbeing Strategy);
- 2. Provide assurance that the Council has plans in place to address member concerns about the condition of some leisure facilities.

Method / Approach

The Review Group will hold meetings virtually with officers and will scrutinise the research, residents' survey and the Leisure and Wellbeing Strategy documentation.

Timescales

23 February, I Iam – Teams meeting to consider the Max Associates research and residents survey

TBC – Teams meeting to consider the obligations of GLL to repair and maintain facilities, the Council's contract monitoring arrangements, future capital works and the use of \$106 to make improvements to leisure facilities.

Late March TBC – Teams meeting to scrutinise the draft Strategic Outcomes Planning Model (Leisure Strategy) before it is presented to the Executive and to agree any recommendations.
